## European Stroke Conference

ENOS and IST-3 hosted a joint stand at ESC in Barcelona and were pleased to see many familiar faces and some new ones. We held an Investigator Meeting with updates on the trial, which was well attended by approximately 70 people.

The COSSACS RESULTS were announced at the main ESC meeting by Prof Tom Robinson and showed a non significant trend to benefit with continue pre stroke antihypertensive therapy. The results showed a clear need to keep recruiting, a position supported by the Data Monitoring Committee who reviewed both ENOS data and the COSSACS results.

## Tips of the month

- For **UK patients** that move centre, the recruiting centre will receive £30 for recruitment and the second centre will receive £15 for data collection and follow up. NIHR SRN will advise on how recruitment will be assigned between centres.
- If a patient is randomised before they have a CT/MRI scan, please carry out and submit a scan done before or on Day 7. We will pay £80 towards the cost of a Day 7 scan, if done after a baseline scan done before recruitment.
- Please submit Carotid Doppler reports whenever possible. If this is not done for routine clinical care, we can pay £30 towards this test. Ensure that "For ENOS only" is written on the carotid Doppler report.
- If you have randomised a patient and have a problem with the ENOS website during the randomisation process, please log back into the website to check if the patient was actually randomised to avoid a duplicate entry. The randomisation may have actually gone through and if so, you will see the patient by logging back in. The randomisation result will be saved for 12 hours before it is removed from the website.
