## Carotid Scans in ENOS

While long term blood pressure control reduces stroke risk, it might paradoxically increase this risk in patients with significant ipsilateral carotid stenosis, and especially if bilateral. Currently there is only limited data to aid clinical practice, and that comes from an interim analysis of early ENOS data. The safety and efficacy of lowering BP in acute stroke in the presence of significant carotid stenosis is a key secondary aim of ENOS.

Unfortunately, many patients enrolled into ENOS do not appear to have carotid imaging, at least on the basis of carotid data entered into the 'Hospital Events' form. This is surprising since carotid scanning can be justified in most patients with ischaemic stroke. If carotid scanning cannot be justified on clinical grounds, then funding of £30 per participant is available; of note, very little of this has been paid out to date! Please try to do carotid scanning on all of your ENOS patients, and remember to enter the data. Then we can all answer this important question.

## Consent forms

The issue of where to file original consent forms has been raised recently. Advice from UK regulatory authority, MHRA and UK Ethics, NRES, is that filing in either the patient medical notes or the Patient Trial file is acceptable. However, best practice advice seems to be to file the original in patient site file. As ENOS is legacy trial, the form states on it that the original should be filed in medical notes, copy to patient site file & patient. The University of Nottingham, as sponsor for ENOS, has agreed that we should remain with our original policy of filing the original consent form in the medical notes. Any local difference in practice should be documented by a file note.
