Baseline form

Section E: Haemodynamics and Other measures, "Admission BP" and "Admission Heart Rate" has been changed to make it clear that this is "Baseline BP" and "Baseline Heart Rate" (ie at the time of enrollment to the trial, not admission to hospital).

- A new "transfer form" has been distributed for use with repatriating patients if patients move in the first 7 days, which should help with the paper trail.
- The person prescribing the GTN patch should be on the delegation log.
