

We would like to welcome Dr Khaled Darawil and his team to ENOS from Queen's hospital, Romford, part of Barking, Havering and Redbridge Hospitals NHS Trust. Queens is one of the busiest stroke units in London, with one of the highest numbers of stroke admissions in the capital. A total of 1,111 emergency admissions with a primary diagnosis of stroke, were admitted in the last financial year.

The 42 bedded unit comprises of 12 hyper acute and 30 rehab beds. Queen's Hospital's HASU (hyper acute stroke unit) was awarded the Stroke Association Prize for the most improved stroke service in the UK in June 2010. They have already recruited their first patient and we wish them the best of luck with their recruitment.



### Time to randomisation



Please try to randomise patients early in the 48 hour window. We only have 10% of patients randomised in the first 12 hours. If the trial is to have a balanced result, we need to recruit at all time periods across the 48 hours.
