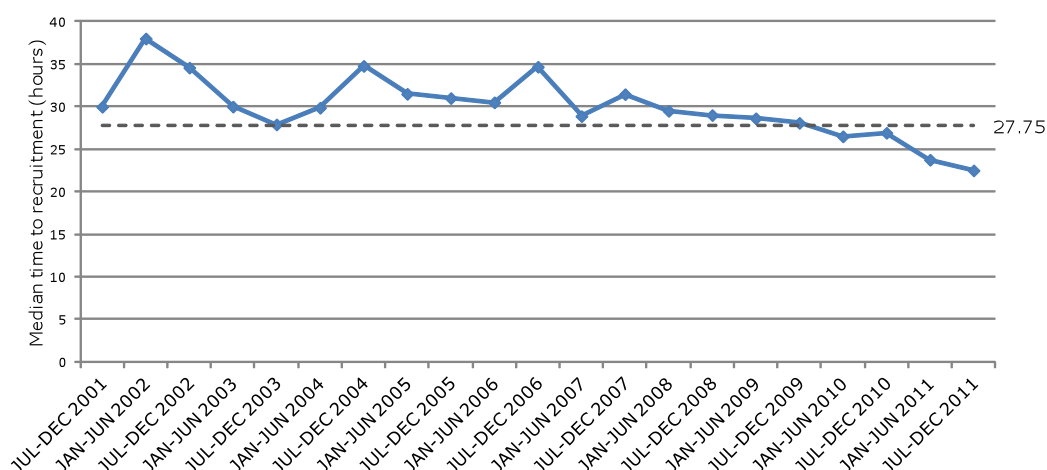
## Time to Randomisation

As you may already be aware, we need to reduce the average time to randomisation. Our current time is 28 hours which has been falling over the duration of the trial – see graph below. However, if this does not continue to fall, we risk the trial being less relevant to clinical practice than it could be.

We will be sending out a survey shortly to seek more information on this issue and would be grateful if you could spend the necessary 15 minutes to fill this in.

Please continue to randomise as early as you can in the meantime.

## Tips of the month

- Please do not forget to ask patients/relatives to **enter their initials** in the tick boxes on all consent forms and not just to tick boxes.
- On the SAE form the “relationship to drug” question should be answered as if you do not know the treatment for the patient.
- Please ensure that blood pressure readings are taken 1-2 hours post-patch.
- The memorable PIN should **not** be used to login to the ENOS website. This is just used to identify the person re-setting the password and your regular login PIN will remain unchanged – see more information overleaf.

## Passwords

We have been receiving numerous requests to change passwords for the ENOS website. We have now added the facility to allow you to reset your own password via the ENOS website, provided that you know your PIN.

The reset option is on the login page. You can use it to request an email, which will contain a link allowing you to change your password. The system will also ask you to set a second PIN, which should be memorable to you personally.

This will not replace your original PIN, but will be requested if you should forget your password again in the future. If you do not know your main PIN, you will still need to call the ENOS office to reset your password.

There is a time limit on the reset and it will automatically time-out if you do not complete the password change within the allotted time. Once a reset email has expired, however, you will have the option to request another one.

If you feel that you should have been paid for recruiting patients to ENOS, it may be that we are still waiting for outstanding documentation, CT scans or answers to queries before this can be made. Please check through your patient trial files to ensure all the necessary information has been sent to us and also entered on the website.
