Time to Randomisation Survey

Thanks to everyone who has completed the survey so far. Initial feedback is as follows:

- 96% of investigators agree that it is important to randomise ENOS patients early in the 48-hour time window.
- 64% of investigators think the protocol should not be changed to force early recruitment but agree with raising awareness.
- 73% of investigators are aware that patients can be enrolled to ENOS after thrombolysis (or even before if feasible).
- Suggestions to improve early recruitment were: ensure that local paramedics are informed and aware of the ENOS trial; increase weekend cover; and contact relatives immediately after admission.

Sickness or maternity leave

Clarification has been received from the Sponsor regarding sickness or maternity leave of the Principal Investigator.

The signature/delegation log should always show a nominated deputy (or two) for the PI to cover absences such as sickness and holiday so that recruitment does not have to stop and that someone is available to assess SAEs for causality and relatedness to the IMP.

Longer planned absences such as maternity leave, or illness that is likely to become longer term, would involve the deputy stepping up as official PI.

Tips of the month

- If, occasionally, blood pressure readings are missing for days 2 to 7, the Day 7 form can be left blank (do not enter a zero) for these fields online and submitted. Please note that BP readings 1-2 hours post patch placement are mandatory. But other BP readings are equally important.
- Please do not fax SAE forms or any form that you enter online. We need faxed documents for patient contact details, consent form, OMRON BP sheet, drug chart, CT report and carotid report (if done).
- If submitting a data correction form on SAEs, please include the SAE number (shown on the website once the SAE has been submitted).

ENOS now has 150 recruiting centres in 19 countries.

ENOS has a low SAE rate (24%) for a 90 day acute stroke trial including ICH patients, and it is especially low overseas. Please ensure that you report **all** SAEs from randomisation to the 90 day Follow Up.
