## Tips of the month

- Patients need to receive the patch as soon after randomisation as possible (1 hour maximum). Please ensure, before randomising, that there is someone available from the delegation log to prescribe the patch immediately if randomised to do so. This may mean obtaining more signatures and personnel on the delegation log in advance.
- When completing the baseline form, the questions pertaining to risk factors refer to patient history prior to their stroke, not since admission. E.g. the question "is the patient currently taking lipid lowering therapy" refers to the time before the stroke, not since admission.

## End of recruitment and closedown

ENOS patient recruitment will end in June 2013, to allow time for 90 day follow up and data chasing. Some centres that are not actively recruiting may have already received the closedown procedure, which will consist of a checklist to be completed by each centre.

All centres that have recruited five patients will be monitored at least once during the trial, so if you have not had a monitoring visit yet, please expect one. Please continue to recruit as many patients as possible to June 2013, to ensure we meet the minimum of 3,500 patients, preferably to get to 4,000.
