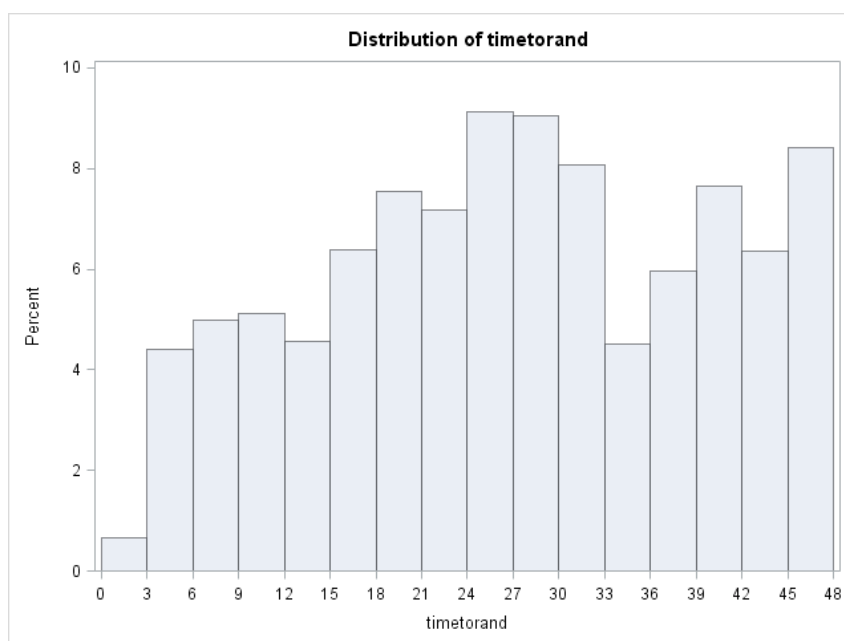

## Time to Randomisation

Recruitment is going well - currently we have 3233 patients randomised, with 1671 in continue-stop pre stroke antihypertensives, these being recruited from 161 sites who have recruited at least one patient.

As you know, a problem from the beginning of the trial is that many patients are recruited in the second day - currently the median time to recruitment is above 24 hours with 41% recruited in day 1 and 59% in day 2, see graph below. The results from patients recruited later will be less likely to inform clinical practice, and this balance between day 1 and day 2 recruitment could be commented on by referees.

The ENOS Trial Steering Committee have considered reducing the time window for recruitment. However, it has been agreed to leave as it is for the remainder of the trial, but to strongly promote early recruitment. We are running regular competitions for early recruitment and see overleaf for current winners.



**ENOS now has 161 recruiting centres in 21 countries.**

- Municipal Hospital, Georgia; Mures County Hospital, Targu-Mures, Romania and Lincoln County Hospital UK for recruiting 9 or more patients in the last 90 days.
- Dunedin Hospital, New Zealand; Northwick Park Hospital, London, UK and Royal Victoria Hospital, Newcastle, UK for each recruiting a patient between 0 and 3 hours of stroke; and Barnsley Hospital UK for recruiting a patient in the shortest time between 3 and 12 hours of stroke onset.
