## Recruitment


I am delighted to tell you that we are rapidly approaching our nominal recruitment target for ENOS, namely the recruitment of 3,500 patients. As of 7 November we have 3,406 patients with over 80 patients recruited in the last month; so, we may make 3,500 patients before the end of this year. This is excellent news and many thanks to all of you for this tremendous effort.

The target of 3,500 patients is only a nominal one and we have regulatory and ethics approvals to go to 5,000 patients (our original target prior to 2011). We would like to continue recruiting and ideally reach 4,000+ patients. Every additional patient adds to the statistical power of the trial and our ability to show that lowering blood pressure is important, if it is important. So please keep recruiting and let's see if we can beat 4,000. When recruiting, please try to recruit as early as possible after admission since we have some limited evidence from our small RIGHT trial that very early treatment with GTN (within 4 hours) might be beneficial through reducing death/dependency.

In the meantime, I would be grateful if you would check your trial file documentation to make sure that your regulatory and ethics approval letters do not limit you to a trial total of less than 5,000 patients - there is no reason why they should, but I would just like everyone to check.

Many thanks and keep up the good work with recruitment.

## CT reminder: Patient Imaging

When uploading or sending in CT or MRI brain scans for a patient, please ensure that this does not include any images where the name of the patient has been incorporated into an actual image. These images are usually called "Dose Reports" or "Protocols". During web upload, data is transferred in encrypted format and anonymised but this process cannot remove any burnt on data that is part of an actual image.

**ENOS now has 162 recruiting centres in 21 countries.**





- Hassleholm Hospital, Sweden for recruiting their first ENOS patient (see photo above).
- Municipal Hospital, Georgia for recruiting 47 patients in the last 90 days.
- St Richards Hospital, Chichester, UK and Wansbeck General and North Tyneside Hospitals, UK for each recruiting a patient between 0 and 3 hours of stroke
- Municipal Hospital, Georgia for recruiting the most patients between 3 and 6 hours of stroke onset. A hamper will be sent to each centre.

**Competition:** To further encourage hyper acute recruitment, there will be more prizes (hampers) for the centre recruiting the most patients in the time window 3-6 hours in **November**. And there will also be a hamper for every centre that recruits a patient in less than 3 hours.

Sharon Ellender recently visited ENOS Centres in Tblisi, Georgia to perform a site monitoring visit. The National Coordinator for Georgia is Prof Maia Beridze. Georgia recruited their first patient on 3 July 2012 and at end October had a total of 74 recruited patients. There are three recruiting centres in Georgia: Barnovi City Hospital, Hospital of War Veterans and Municipal Hospital. The Municipal Hospital have recruited very successfully with 47 patients in 90 days and many are recruited early in the time window. They have just been awarded a hamper for their recruitment in October by recruiting two patients in the 3-6 hour time window.
