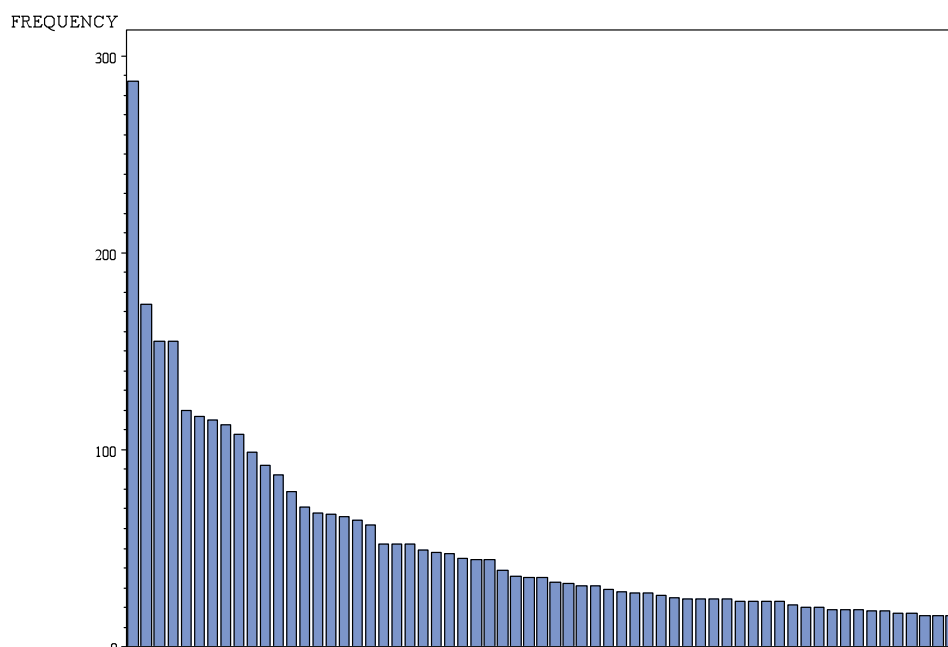
## Recruitment and Closedown

ENOS closed to recruitment on 14 October 2013, 12 noon GMT. We recruited a grand total of 4011 patients into the whole trial and 2097 into the continue-stop arm. A massive thanks to all of you for your major contribution; the trial reflects your commitment and dedication.

We are now in the process of data cleaning and closedown. You will receive queries and emails from us to make this happen. Please respond as quickly and accurately as possible. We appreciate that this takes time, but we need to ensure the data is as high quality as possible and prompt to ensure we can analyse the results in time.

We aim to present the results at the European Stroke Congress in Nice, May 2014. There will be an Investigator Meeting on Tuesday 6 May at the NH Hotel. Invitations will be issued shortly, and at least 1 representative from each recruiting centre will be invited.
