ENOS closed to recruitment on 14 October 2013, 12 noon GMT.

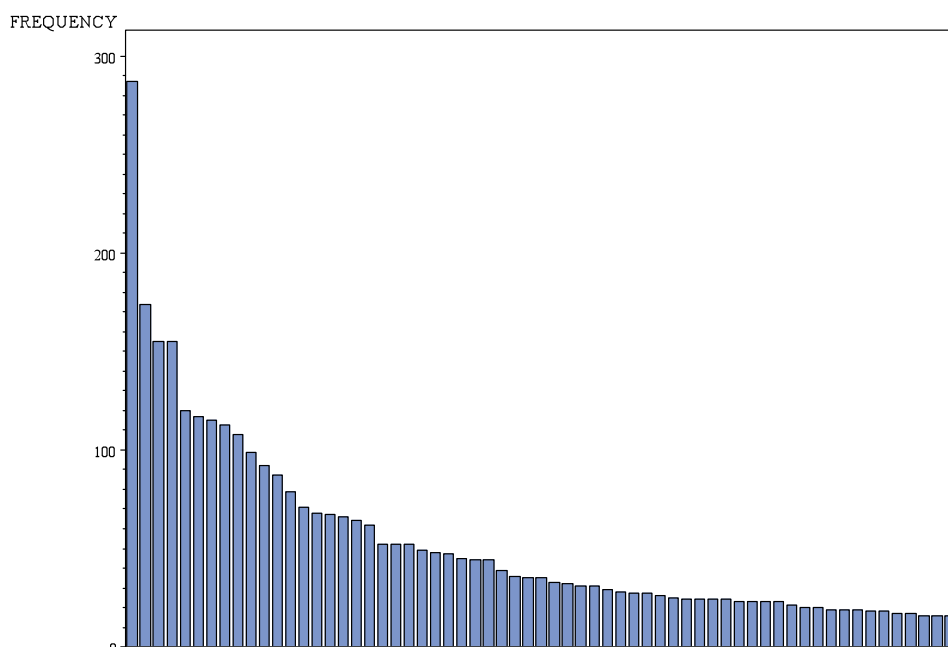
Thanks to everyone for their contribution and ongoing submission of data and queries.
