Data Monitoring Committee

The Data Monitoring Committee met on 3 December 2007 and reviewed data for 795 patients. The Committee had no concerns and recommend that the trial continues. The approval letter is posted on the ENOS website.

Tips of the month

CTA - ENOS has a new CTA number. Please note this is now 03057/0017/001.

Password change – A password change option will be available in the New Year within the ENOS website to allow investigators to change their password. Passwords will need to be changed at least every year and will need to be at least 8 characters long, with a combination of upper/lower case and alphanumeric characters.

CT Scans - Please note that we are only able to pay for day 7 scans (± 1 day) when the baseline scan is completed before randomisation.

We are aware that we have made a lot of form changes recently and we are trying to minimise this for the future. However, please be aware that we have submitted a substantial amendment to the ENOS protocol, sent to MREC and MHRA on 16 November, which also includes a new PIS/consent forms and new GP letter and is likely to be released in the New Year. Please note, this amendment clarifies issues rather than changing the protocol.
