ENOS jointly hosted a stand with the IST-3 trial at the UKSF and met with many UK colleagues.








Thanks for all the entries to the caption competition. The winning centre is Scarborough, with the entry "He should have been voted off last week". A Christmas Hamper is on the way to them.
