
# Time to Randomisation

The ENOS Trial Steering Committee met recently for its annual review of the trial and, on review of the data, would like to see more patients randomised earlier in the 48 hour time window. Currently, only 10% of ENOS patients are randomised within 12 hours of stroke onset.

We are aware from discussions with investigators and coordinators that although many patients present to hospital within a few hours, a considerable delay can occur before enrolment, often with hospitalisation on one day and enrolment on the next. We fully understand that this can be for operational reasons, but also know that it is possible to recruit much sooner. This has been demonstrated in thrombolysis trials and even other large academic trials such as IMAGES (which had a 12 hour recruitment window and had a good spread over the 12 hours). Fast recruitment is possible in ENOS, as shown in the recruitment graph below.

The Trial Steering Committee and all of us in the Coordinating Centre hope that you can enrol patients as soon as possible after presentation to hospital.

- OMRON machines Do not forget to change the time on your OMRON machines to comply with your local time changes.
- **SAEs** Please do not state "complication of initial stroke" if 4 weeks has passed since the original date of stroke onset.
- CTs Randomisation should not be delayed by waiting for a CT/MRI scan.
   Patients can be enrolled into ENOS without a baseline CT.
- Documents. Ensure you forward all documents and CTs to ENOS Trial Office to ensure payment for patient recruitment is received.
- Please fax completed GTN accountability form to +44 (0) 115 823 1771.
